GUIDELINES

- There is no entry fee.
- Eligibility is limited to students enrolled in class(es) during the Summer 2016, Fall 2016, or Spring 2017 semesters.
- The exhibition is limited to works that have been produced for a course taught at the Glassell School of Art under the direction of an instructor and as fulfillment of a course project either in class or as an assignment during the last year. Junior School and APP student works are not eligible.
- Each student may submit only one (1) work for consideration by the jury. Instructors may not select or submit student works for consideration.
- A completed entry form must accompany the work.
- All work must be original. No prints of original artwork, including giclee. Slides, images, and incomplete works will not be accepted.
- All work must be in suitable condition for exhibition, i.e. dry and fixed.
- All work is to be unframed. It is not necessary to matte work, but if the student chooses to do so, only white mattes will be accepted.
- Oversize pieces will be considered as space permits.

WORK INTAKE

- Deliver to Glassell School of Art, Thursday, May 11 and Friday, May 12, 10:00 a.m.–9:30 p.m.
 - 2-D work should be placed in Room 214 Printmaking.
 - Jewelry should be placed in Sandie Zilker’s office in the administrative office. If needed, a staff member will assist you.
 - 3-D work should be placed in Room 200 Sculpture/Ceramics.

INSTALLATION

- Wednesday, May 17 and Thursday, May 18
 - Note: The jury retains the right to amend their selection until the installation process is complete.
 - All works selected must remain on view for the duration of the exhibition, May 19–June 30, 2017.

WORK PICK-UP / UNSELECTED WORK

- Tuesday, May 23 and Wednesday, May 24, 9:00 a.m.–9:30 p.m.
 - Unaccepted work should be picked up at this time only. You or your representative will be required to sign for your work.

WORK PICK-UP / EXHIBITED WORK

- Wednesday, July 5–Friday, July, 7
 - Exhibited work should be picked up at this time only. You or your representative will be required to sign for your work.

OPENING RECEPTION & AWARD PRESENTATION

- Friday, May 19, 6:00–8:00 p.m.
 - Best of Show and Honorable Mention will be awarded by the jurors.
