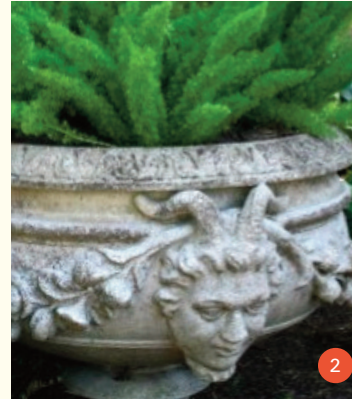

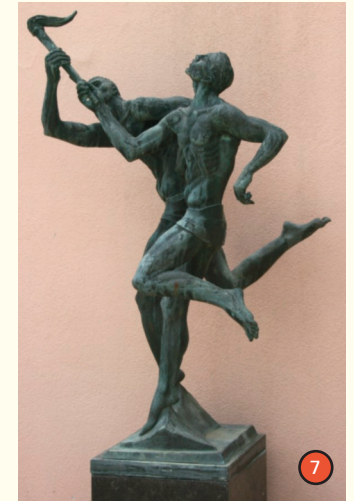
☐ These peacocks nestle under shade-loving ferns, with a view over the ravine.



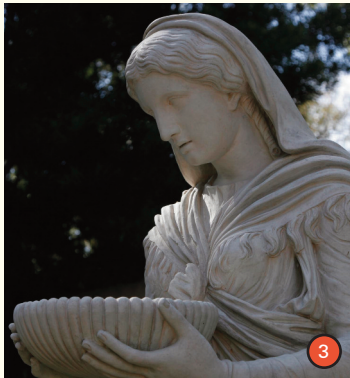
☐ This face is a composite, or mix. What animal feature does the man have?



☐ This contemplative, or thoughtful, lady watches over Rienzi's pool.



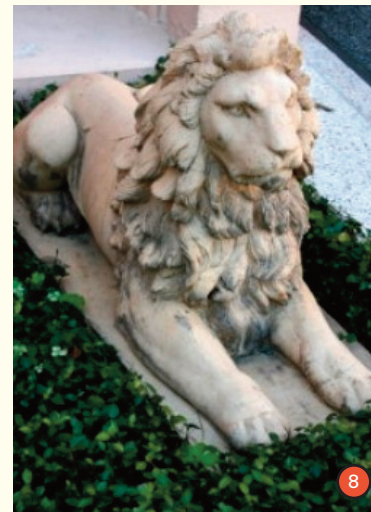
☐ Texas sculptor Charles J. Umlauf created this dynamic bronze of sprinting torchbearers.



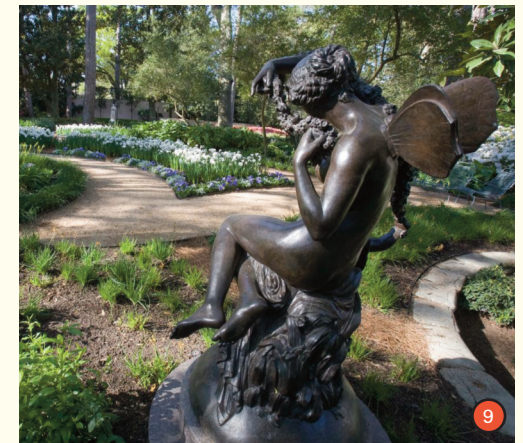
☐ Lady Gandes watches over the French Baroque garden. Can you find her?
